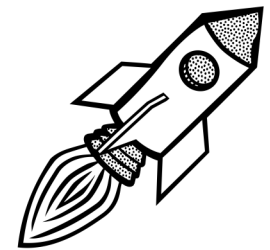

How can we be **GREEN** when it comes to protecting our sewers?

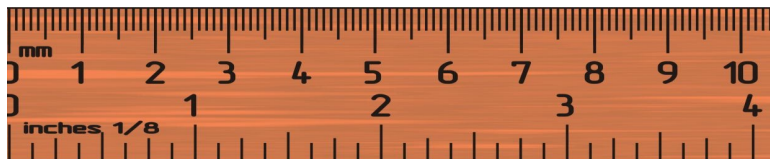
- There is no such thing as a flushable wipe (never flush any type of wipe down the toilet)

- Reduce water waste



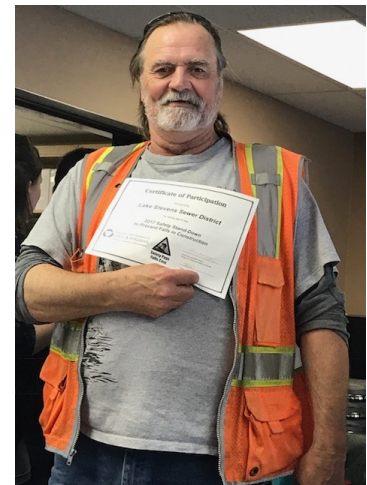
Sewer Knowledge:
